

GATALOP Rules

For Service Animals

The Barony of the Osprey welcomes ADA approved Service Animals to Gatalop. For the safety of both animals and humans alike please review the following rules.

1. ADA requires all Service Animals to wear their current rabies vaccine tags at all times. The tag number and expiration date must match those recorded on the Service Animals Waiver that is filed With event registration (Troll).
2. **Under the ADA, service animals must be harnessed, leashed, or tethered, unless these devices interfere with the service animal's work or the individual's disability prevents using these devices.** In that case, the individual must maintain control of the animal through voice, signal, or other effective controls. When off duty Service Animals must be in a turn out pen or crate and under supervision. In no way is the SCA or the event Staff responsible for safety or well being of attending Service Animals.
3. Service Animals showing aggression towards others (animals or persons) or damaging personal or fort property will be asked to leave if the disruptive behavior is not corrected.
4. Owners must clean up after their animals in a timely manner and dispose of waste properly.
5. Owners are expected to follow local, state and city laws or they will be barred from the current activity and brought to the attention of the autocrat.
6. An owner(s) must realize that accidents do happen from time to time in canine activities, and assumes responsibility for any injury to his own service animals. The owner(s) is also responsible for all damages done by their service animal.
7. According to ADA guide lines in effect March 2011, the only recognized service animal is a canine, not breed restricted. In some very special instances, miniature horses maybe allowed.

It is understood that the SCA does NOT provide any insurance coverage for the Service Animals. The Service Animal's owner(s) acknowledge that they are responsible for the Service Animal's safety, health care needs, and for the protection of the Service Animal's property.

Service Animal's Owner(s) understand that this document is complete unto itself and that any oral promises or representations made to them concerning this document and/or its terms are not binding upon the SCA, its officers, agents and/or employees.
